This decade has been marked by WAR across the globe with the conflicts in Europe and the Middle East raising fears that we stand on the brink of World War 3 bringing with it the possibility of a nuclear conflict.

As a junior partner to the USA, Britain now appears set to allow Ukraine to use British Storm Shadow missiles to strike Russian territory and is continuing to supply Israel with weapons that could result in the whole of the Middle East being dragged into a terrible firestorm.

While the Starmer government pleads poverty at home with continuing attacks on public services and benefits there is plenty of money for weapons. Old people left unable to heat their homes over the next few months will suffer.

### Can we build support to end war and create peace?

Calderdale Trades Union Council are delighted that Andrew Feinstein and Professor Paul Rogers will be speaking alongside Jenny Lynn of Halifax Friends of Palestine at this public meeting.

**Professor Paul Rogers** is Emeritus Professor of Peace Studies at Bradford University and has written/edited 30 plus books including in 2006: *A War too far: Iraq, Iran and the New American century*.

**Andrew Feinstein** was elected as an ANC MP in South Africa's first democratic elections. He later moved to London to work as an investigative author and campaigner. At the 2024 General Election, Andrew stood as an independent candidate in Holborn and St Pancras. He came second with 18% of the vote to Keir Starmer, who he heavily criticised over the latter's failure to seek a permanent ceasefire in Gaza. He serves on the board of Declassified UK.
