We face a rise in racism across our society. Some politicians and the right wing media seek someone to blame for years of austerity.

Migrants and refugees are constantly scapegoated. EU nationals are being used as bargaining chips in Brexit negotiations.

We've seen a dramatic rise in Islamophobic attacks in the wake of terror attacks in London and Manchester.

Institutional racism is expressed through deaths in police custody, the tragedy at Grenfell Tower and systematic

discrimination in employment and housing.

In the US we have Trump, his 'wall' and his Muslim ban. In Europe we see the rise of the Freedom Party in Austria, the Front National in France and the AfD in Germany.

We need a mass movement against racism.

The Stand Up To Racism marches in London, Glasgow and Cardiff on Saturday 17 March (marking UN anti-racism day) are an important step in building that movement.
